Instructions: Key Radio, press \* on your keypad. This will alert any stations listening on frequency of **EMERGENCY OPERATIONS**.

ATTENTION ALL DECATUR COUNTY AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS, THIS IS A SEVERE WEATHER NET INITIATED AT THE REQUEST OF THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN INDIANAPOLIS. THE DECATUR COUNTY AREA IS UNDER A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM/TORNADO WARNING UNTILAM/PM. THIS WILL BE A DIRECTED NET AND STATIONS ARE REQUESTED TO TRANSMIT ONLY IN THE DIRECTION OF NET CONTROL EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF EMERGENCY. THIS IS, MY NAME ISAND I WILL BE SERVING AS THE NET CONTROL OPERATOR DURING THIS NET. IS THERE ANY EMERGENCY TRAFFIC AT THIS TIME? I WILL NOW ACCEPT CHECKINS FOR THE NET – PLEASE INDICATE YOUR STATUS AS A BASE OR MOBILE AND YOUR AVAILIBILITY FOR GOING MOBILE AS A WEATHER SPOTTER:

[Check with liaison to the NWS and for radar reports as necessary.  Dispatch spotters to their normal location or elsewhere as indicated by the track of the storm
system. Obtain rain amounts and wind speeds, ( <i>determine if measured or estimated</i> as well as reports of downed trees, limbs, power lines etc]
Upon release from NWS service, conclude proceedings:
